## Background

## Professional and industry experience

Anna's experience includes preparing valuations and quantum calculations and drafting expert witness reports and joint statements. She has worked on many cases over the last seven years, including UNICITRAL, LCIA, ICC and CEPANI arbitrations, as well as High Court and other forums.

Examples of disputes that Anna has worked on include:

- valuation of the impact of alleged fraud and/or breach of warranties in a €2 billion claim relating to the sale of a pharmaceutical company (arbitration)
- assessing the profits arising out of certain onshore oil fields in West Africa (arbitration)
- assisting in the valuation of a share in an oil field project off West Africa including modelling the revenue and cash flows (arbitration)
- assessing lost energy and capacity payments at a power station on in the Indian sub-continent due to the actions of a counterparty in failing to supply gas (arbitration)

- loss of profit analysis relating to various transfers between connected Indian companies to demonstrate the leak of value to the detriment of the overseas investor (arbitration)
- valuation of assets (media and retail) for a matrimonial dispute
- assisting the expert determiner in a €50 million closing balance sheet dispute concerning stock (inventory) of rolled steel products
- assessing loss of profits in relation to an insurance claim by a light aircraft manufacturer
- preparation of an advisory valuation report for a kitchen appliance producer in the early stages of a dispute
- analysing the costs incurred by a Middle-Eastern family management company
- valuation of a brewery and pub-chain for a family dispute
- assessment of account of profits and Wrotham Park damages of a Fund following the departure of certain senior individuals from the Fund Management team
